How to Maintain Your Interlocks

....The Right Way!



We have found that many people use liquid based lubricants. **STOP!** Lubricants such as WD-40 perform well in the immediate term, however, it creates long term problems.

Liquid based lubricants gum up over time and often solidify. This jams up the lock and often causes operators to use excessive force in an attempt to overcome the lock, usually resulting in lock and/or key damage.

What should you use?

Graphite Powder

Graphite powder is a dry lubricant making it ideal for locks and applications where you cannot clean out old used oils or liquid lubricants.

Graphite powder is widely available and can be purchased from most hardware stores.
